**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that a Public Hearing will be held by the County Legislature of the County of Steuben at the Legislative Chambers, 20 East Morris Street, in the Village of Bath, New York, on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. relative to land submitted for inclusion in certified Agricultural District 6 during the 2023 annual thirty-day review period, to consider the recommendations of the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board, and proposed modifications of said agricultural district.

A description of the district with proposed modifications may be examined during business hours at the Steuben County Planning Office, 20 East Morris Street, in the Village of Bath, New York.

It is the recommendation of the Agricultural and Farmland Protection Board that the parcels submitted for inclusion in Steuben County certified Agricultural District 6 during the 2023 annual thirty-day period under Article 25AA, Section 303-b of the Agriculture and Markets Law of the State of New York be included in the respective district.
