**WHEREAS**, CASA-Trinity has requested \$253,957 to open a Recovery Center and expand AIR services; and

**WHEREAS**, Catholic Charities Steuben/Livingston has requested \$120,000 to support the Prevention Coalition's/ Opioid Committee in harm reduction and prevention efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, Family Service Society, Inc. has requested \$159,362 to fund a part-time Prevention Specialist and obtain a van for transportation to increase outreach efforts and prevention counseling at the Corning Youth Center; and

**WHEREAS**, the Human Services Health & Education and Finance committees recommend the funding requests; and

**WHEREAS**, \$282,326 of the \$533,319 amount has already been appropriated in the 2024 operating budget.
