HEALTH
DIRECTOR'S
ORDER

WHEREAS, 2019-Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCoV) is an infection associated with fever and signs and symptoms of pneumonia or other respiratory illness, appears to be transmitted from person to person predominantly through droplet transmission and, if spread in the population, could have significant public health consequences; and

WHEREAS, 2019-nCoV is believed to have emerged as a human pathogen in China in December 2019; and

WHEREAS, Article 21 of the new York Public Health Law mandates that all local health officers, being Commissioners of Health and Public Health Directors, as the case may be, of County Health Departments, guard against the introduction of such communicable diseases as are designated in the State Sanitary Code, by the exercise of proper and vigilant medical inspection and control of all persons and things infected with or exposed to such diseases; and

WHEREAS, 10 NYCRR 2.13 provides that whenever a case of a highly communicable disease (as defined in 10 NYCRR Section 2.1) comes to the attention of the local health officer of a county, such local health officer shall isolate such patients as in his judgment he deems necessary;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me by section 2100 of the Public Health Law of the State of New York and 10 NYCRR 2.13 as Public Health Director of STEUBEN County, I do hereby:

ORDER that, as of 1/10/22, you are hereby directed to travel directly to, if not

This is the **start date**. For **positives**: the start date is EITHER the first day you had symptoms OR the day you were tested if you did not have symptoms.
For **contacts**: this is the most recent date you were exposed by a positive.
This is day 0. In this example, day 1 starts 1/11/22. You must remain isolated or quarantined for 5 full days after the date entered here.

1 Main St. Bath, NY 14810

This is the **address** where the positive or contact will be staying during their isolation or quarantine. The person who these orders are for should not leave this location during the dates indicated on their order.

through 1/15/22

If asymptomatic at the end of this 5 day period or if symptoms are resolving, you are hereby ordered to

This is **5 days after your start date** and serves as the last date of isolation or quarantine. **After** this date, you are considered released from isolation or quarantine.

1/20/22

This is **10 days after your start date** (and 5 days after the end of isolation/quarantine). After the release from isolation or quarantine the positive or contact must continue to wear a mask for 5 more days through this date.

the State Commissioner of Health may issue; OR if the location is a multiple dwelling structure, you may go outside while remaining on the premises within 6 feet of any person who does not reside at the premise, and remain consistent with any direction that the State Commissioner of Health may issue.

FURTHER, I DO HEREBY give notice that you have a right to be represented by legal counsel or to have counsel provided and that if you qualify to have counsel provided, such counsel will be made available. Moreover, you may supply to the County Health Department the addresses and/or telephone numbers of friends and/or relatives to receive notification of your quarantine/isolation. At your request, the County Health Department shall provide notice to a reasonable number of such persons that you are being quarantined/isolated pursuant to this order


Please note: Falsification of a Quarantine/Isolation order is punishable by law. Further Any person who violates a public health order shall be subject to all civil and criminal penalties as

provided for by law. For purposes of civil penalties, each day that the order is violated shall constitute a separate violation of this Part.
