

How to do a Write-In on a Ballot

To vote for a candidate whose name is not on the ballot:

- Locate the office you wish to do a write-in for
- Go to the bottom of that column
- In the write-in box fill in the Oval in the write-in box and clearly print the name of the person you wish to vote for.

Example

A Write-In will only be counted for the office it appears in on the ballot. It will not count for any another office.

A Write-In counts as a vote. Do not make more selection for an office than is allowed.

Write-Ins for fictional characters (Donald Duck, Mickey Mouse, etc.), professional athletes, actors, etc., are counted as a miscellaneous vote.

It is important to stay within the write-in box.
