A local law Authorizing the Sale of Certain Property Owned by the County of

of STEUBEN as follows:

SECTION 1. The Chairman of the Steuben County Legislature be, and the same hereby is, authorized and directed for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00), and payment of advertising costs, to convey to John H. McIntire the following tract of land:

ALL THAT PIECE OR PARCEL OF PROPERTY hereinafter designated as Tax Map No. 261-1-008.2, situated in the Town of Bath, County of Steuben, State of New York, described as follows:

Starting at a point on the existing property line between Steuben County Department of Public Works and John McIntire said point being north 08°15'03" west, a distance of 195.89' from the property corner between John McIntire and N.F. Andrews, thence north 01°04'12" east, a distance of 307.62' to a point thence along an arc 296.49' said arc having an angle of 09°10'57" and radius 1850.00' to a point on the property line between John McIntire and N.F. Andrews, thence south 81°43'40" west a distance of 65', thence south 08°16'20" east, a distance of 286.5' thence south 06°36'48" east, a distance of 310.21± ft. to the point of beginning and containing 0.46 acres more or less. Map on file in County Public Works Department.

Steuben County reserves the right to clean and maintain any drainage ditches.

SUBJECT to all easements and rights-of-way of record.

SECTION 2. The within statute shall be construed as an offer to convey to, and option to purchase the subject premise, by John H. McIntire. Failure or refusal to furnish consideration on or before December 31, 1994 shall terminate the within offer.

SECTION 3. This local law shall become effective subject to a permissive referendum, forty-five (45) days after the date of its final adoption and on the date it is duly filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of New York and in accordance with the provisions of the Municipal Home Rule Law of the State of New York.




